Phase I – Hilltop Construction in Progress Innes at Donahue Streets

Thirty-five years after the Navy left, there is new life at the Shipyard. Streets and sidewalks have been laid. Nearly \$100 million has been invested to date preparing for the new homes that are about to go up. Lennar is anticipating that the first homes should hit the market in early 2012. The complete build out of the first 1,400 homes at the Shipyard is expected to be completed by 2015.

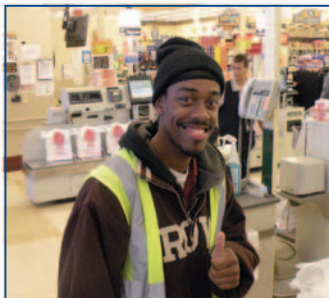

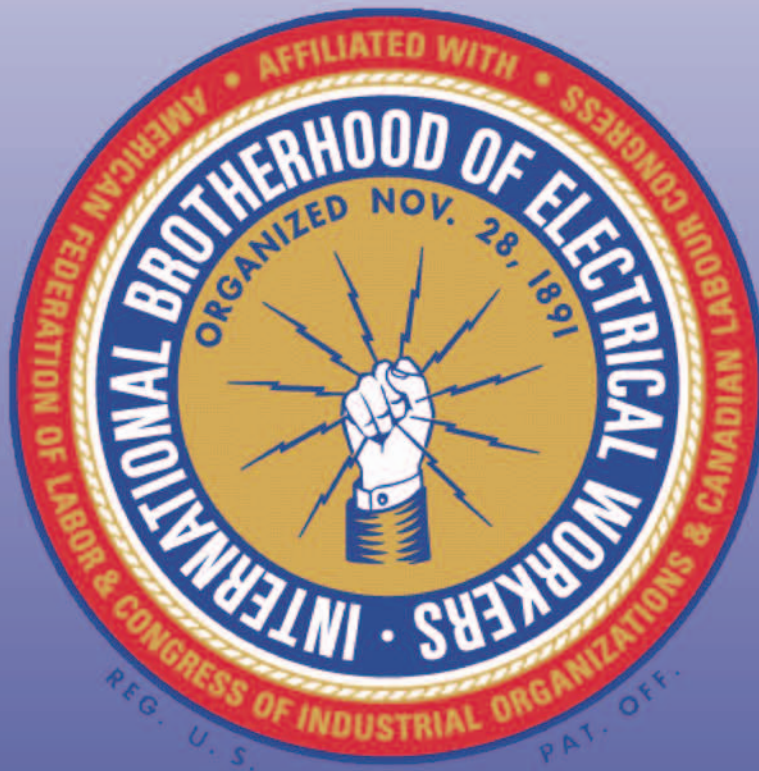

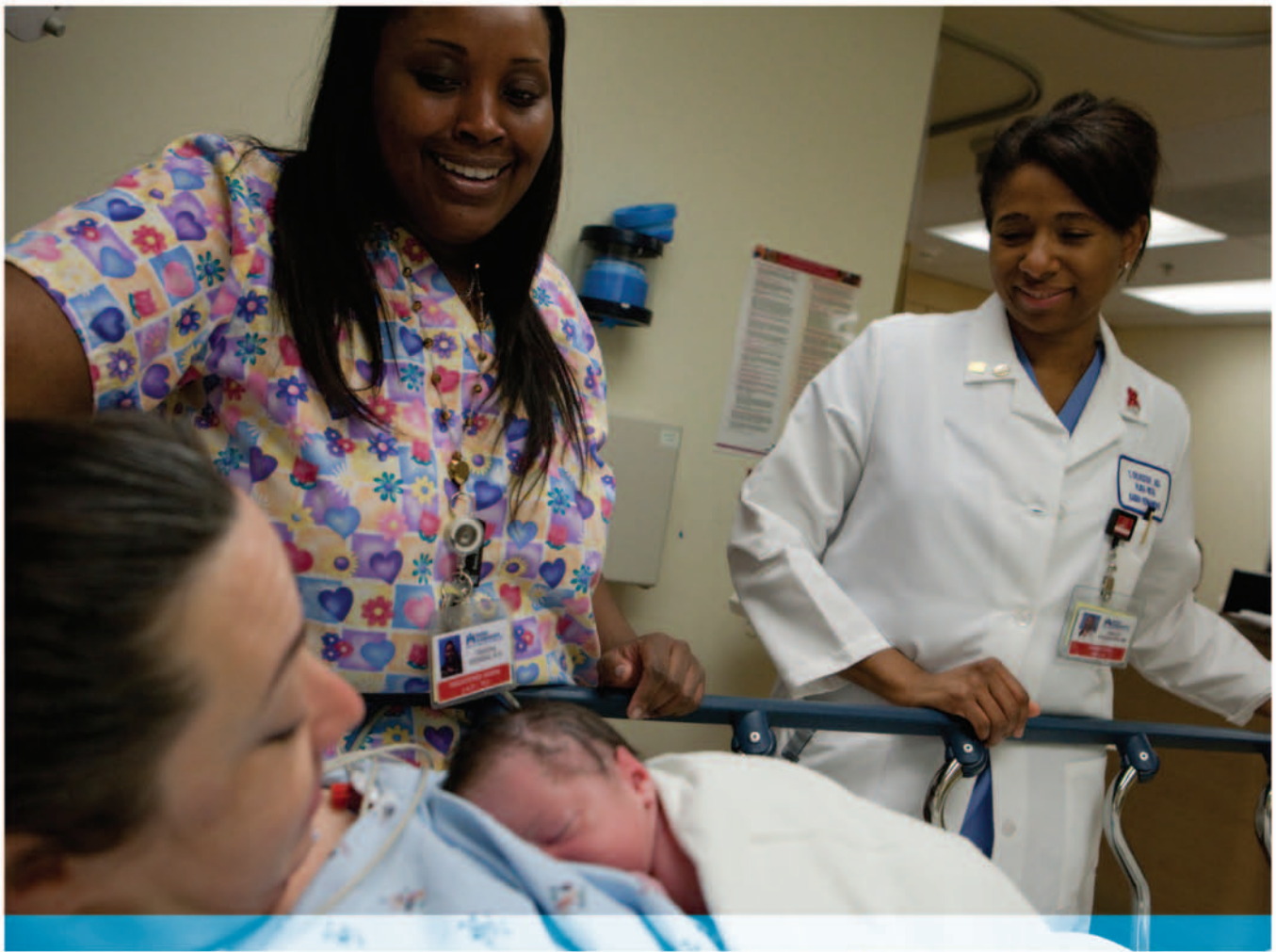
